CLASS 3 Novice

Dressage Test: Pony Club Novice Dressage Test 2009
Show Jumping: Maximum height 85 cm

CLASS 4 Intermediate

Dressage Test: Pony Club Intermediate Dressage Test 2013
Show Jumping: Maximum height 95 cm

CLASS 5 Open

Dressage Test: Pony Club Open Dressage Test 2008
Show Jumping: Maximum height 1.05m

RULES

1. All classes will be run under the Pony Club Dressage and Show Jumping Rules 2013
2. Class 1 is restricted to genuine novice riders only. Persons entering Class 1 may not enter Classes 2 – 5 competitively but may enter HC.
3. Dressage tests may be called. Outside assistance will be permitted in Class 1 only.
4. Classes may be split into sections.
5. The decision of the organising committee and judges will be final.
6. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any classes if there are insufficient entries. Refunds will be given only in the event of cancellation of classes or the event.
7. Competitors must wear protective headgear conforming to Pony Club requirements at all times when mounted. Hats of Pony Club members must be tagged.
8. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
9. Please do not leave litter or muck on the show site.
10. By attending this event, all persons (including competitors, spectators, parents and trainers) agree to abide by the Pony Club Area 5 Code of Conduct. Persons disregarding the Code or these Rules may be asked to leave the event, at the organising committee's discretion.
