Tack and turnout will be inspected in the collecting ring

Riding hats MUST be CE marked with one of the following quality symbols, BSI kitemark, Snell 2001, SAI Global and have a Pony Club tag. It must be worn with chin strap fastened at all times when mounted. Medical armbands and BETA approved body protectors must be worn

The organisers reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition

The X_C course will be available to walk from 2pm on Saturday 12th April
