#### Rules of Entry

- 1 The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entries. The same combination may not ride more than once in the same class. Pony may not do more than a total of 2 Cross Country rounds.
- 2 Competitor may be disqualified from any class for causing any unnecessary delay to the continuity of the event.
- 3 Entry fees are NOT refundable under any circumstances after the close of entry unless cancelled by the organisers or on presentation of a current Vet's certificate or Doctor's note.
- 4a A timed section will be marked on the course. The competitor closest to the optimum time and with the fewest penalties will be the winner.
- 4b Any outside assistance or interference by anyone other than an OFFICIAL, (except in Classes 1,2 and 3), will incur elimination.
- 5 Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the occurrence or the publishing of results accompanied by a £20 deposit. No video evidence will be considered under any circumstances
- 6 <u>Legal Liability</u>. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accept any liability for any accident, loss damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other persons or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
- 7 No horses/ponies under 4 years of age allowed to compete.
- 8 <u>Health and Safety.</u> The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
- 9 HAT REGULATIONS It is mandatory to wear a protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed. It must bear the CE mark and a quality symbol. PAS 015:1998, EN 1384:1996, BS EN 1384:1997 together with the BSI Kitemark. Snell E2001, with the official Snell label and number, AS/NZS 3838 1998, AS/NZS 3838 2003 with the SAI Global symbol. The CE symbol on its own is not sufficient. Hats must be worn when mounted, with chin strap fastened at all times. Hats with long ventilation slits are not allowed for anyone over the age of 9 yrs old. Hats with vertical plastic/metallic strips are permitted. It is strongly recommended that a jockey skull cap be worn cross country (see PC Rules 2015). Hats tags should be worn.
- 10 Riders must wear an effective Body Protector AND long sleeves for Cross Country. It is strongly advised that the body protector chosen should neither impede flexibility nor balance. Air jackets must be worn with a hard body protector.
- 11 Hair must be restrained and in a hair net if long. NO HAIR below the collar. No watches, electronic devices or jewellery allowed.
- 12 Cream/beige jodhpurs must be worn. Numnahs must be plain navy, brown, black, cream or white with the same colour binding.
- 13 Medical armbands with rider's relevant details to be worn on the arm for Cross Country classes.
- 14 A £5.00 deposit will be required for bibs for the riding section.
- 15 Only one family member per competitior at the pool side.
- 16. Guns rules as per Pony Club Tetrathlon rule book 2015
   No person under the age of 17 is allowed to carry a gun. Anyone found doing so will be eliminated from the competition.
   Guns must not be unboxed until authorised by the steward.

Guns must be kept hidden and locked away after use.

- 17. Dogs must be kept on short leads (not extended) at all times, No dogs on the Saturday
- 18. IF NON PONY CLUB COMPETITOR, YOU MUST SIGN TO STATE YOU HAVE 3<sup>RD</sup> PARTY LIABILITY INSURANCE COVER.
- 19. Horseware National Hunter Trial qualifier this competition will be a qualifier for the Horseware National Hunter Trials Championships which will take place at Eland Lodge on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2015.
