Express Eventing consists of a dressage test and a combined show jumping and cross country course

We will run 30,40,60, then finish with 80cm class

Multiple entries encouraged, to build confidence.

Rules:

- 1) The judge's decision is final
- 2) No liability can be accepted by the organisers or land owners for any loss, damage, accident or illness of riders, horses, ponies, vehicles or to any persons or property whatsoever
- 3) The show organisers reserve the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries
- 4) All hats must be to the standard required in Pony Club Health, Safety and Safeguarding Rules 2017. No fixed peaks for jumping phase.**
- 5) Body protectors must be worn for the jumping phase and must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard**
- 6) Riders must wear safe and suitable footwear and have long sleeves for jumping. All tack should be in good condition and safe. Pony Club members will be tack checked.
- 7) Dressage phase: 80cm class, full PC competition rules apply, i.e.: snaffle bridle, no martingale, no boots on horse. All other classes, any bit allowed and martingales permitted.
- 8) Please take your rubbish home
- 9) In the event of adverse weather conditions, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event

4.	E Circle left 15m diameter.	10	Rhythm, balance and suppleness. Size and shape of circle.
5.	Between A&F Transition to working canter left.	10	Balance and activity in the transition.
6.	FMCHK Working canter.	10	Rhythm, suppleness and balance.
7.	Between K&A Transition to working trot.	10	Balance and activity in the transition. Rhythm and balance in trot.

19.	Submission	10	Attention and confidence, harmony, lightness and ease of the movements, acceptance of the bridle and lightness of the forehand.
20.	Rider position and seat	10 x 2	Correctness and effect of the aids.
