

SCHEDULE

CLASS 1 REGIONAL TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

For members of any age not to have previously represented their branch or Centre at Novice level or above in Area Eventing or Show Jumping competitions.

First round not to exceed 80cm, second round x2 fences may be 85cm

The first 8 teams will qualify for the Regional Championships

The first 8 individuals not in one of the qualifying teams will qualify for Regional Championships

CLASS 2A Novice Area Inter- Branch Team Competition.

CLASS 2B Open Novice & Novice Area Individual Competition

Course as above & to include all Team Members from Class 2A

CLASS 3A Intermediate Area Inter-Branch Team Competition.

CLASS 3B Intermediate Area Inter-Branch Individual Competition

Course as above & to include all Team Members from Class 3A

CLASS 4A Open Area Inter-Branch Team Competition.

CLASS 4B Open Area Individual Competition.

Course as above & to include all Team Members from Class 4A

A TACK CHECK WILL PRECEDE THE START OF EACH CLASS.

Entry Fee (incl 1st Aid): Classes £22 per competitor

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Competition will be run in accordance with the **Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2018**- these rules are also available online
2. All **entries** must comply with the Entry Rules and Guidance and be signed by the District Commissioner of the entrant's branch.
3. **Hats** must comply with the current Pony Club minimum standards and be tagged with the 2018 turquoise tag before competitors commence any jumping.
4. **Horses/ponies** to be at least 5 years old.
5. The **Official Steward's** decision is final.
6. **Substitutions may** be permitted after the closing date for declarations subject to Rule 32 of the PCSJR 2018 No team substitutions allowed once the Competition has started.
7. **Teams** shall comprise 3 or 4 members of the same Pony Club Branch or Centre but individuals may be combined into a team pursuant to rule 30(a) of the PCSJR 2018 or 30(b) for the Open team competition
8. Teams and individuals must report to the collecting ring for a **Tack check** at least 30 minutes before the time they are scheduled to jump in the first round.
9. **Objections** must be lodged in writing, with a £10 deposit, to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident or results being published, whichever is the sooner.
10. A Pony Club competitor wishing to wear **spurs** must carry a note of permission from their District Commissioner. (B test holders exempt.)
11. No entry fees will be considered for **refund** after closure of entries.
12. The Organiser reserves the right to **alter the schedule** at any time prior to the Competition.
13. **The organisers request that each branch provides 4 adult helpers for their own team during each round to act as pole pickers**

AWARDS

PRESENTATIONS WILL BE MADE APPROX 30 MINUTES AFTER THE RESULTS ARE POSTED

Regional competition –

Team rosettes awarded to 8th place, and individual rosettes awarded to the top 8 individuals not in qualifying teams.

Area Competition-

Rosettes are awarded to the Members of the first six teams and the first six individuals.

Prizes only awarded if the rider is present at the prize giving. The organisers reserve the right to amend awards presented.

Members MUST be correctly dressed for prize giving.

INFORMATION PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION WILL BE DISPLAYED ON THE PONY CLUB AREA 5 & BRANCH WEBSITES.

A VALID PASSPORT AND VACCINATION RECORD MUST ACCOMPANY THE HORSE TO ALL AREA LEVEL COMPETITIONS AND ABOVE

OBJECTIONS

Any query about a competitor's score must be made only at the secretary's office. No approach may be made to the judge, time keeper, fence judge or any other official. **Only District Commissioners** or their appointed representatives are entitled to lodge **objections**. They must be made **in writing** to the secretary's office, addressed to the Official Steward and accompanied by a deposit of £25. **Objections** must be made within **half an hour** (i) of the relevant incident or (ii) after the scores are published or (iii) after dressage score sheets are released. The Official Steward will give her decision which shall be final.
