## **RULES**

### **Triathlon - Conditions of entry**

To be run in accordance with 2019 Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules.

The decisions of the judges are final throughout.

For insurance purposes, all competitors must be paid-up members of their Pony Club branch.

Objections Run times will be posted at the running. Any queries should be taken up with the phase steward at that point and no more than 30 minutes after the scores are put up or posted on the noticeboard.

Objections must be made to the Secretary within 30 minutes.

Shooting Guns must be brought to tables in their boxes and opened only on command of the firing point steward. They must be boxed again before the competitor leaves the firing point.

Guns may only be carried by those over 18 years or under the supervision of a person over 21 years.

When not in use, guns must be stored in a secure place (ie, in a vehicle, out of sight).

Any breach of safety rules may result in disqualification.

Please ensure competitors are aware that footwear must not cover the ankle (ie. no boots) and all competitors shooting at the 7m distance must wear eye protection.

Please refer to 2019 rule book to adhere to the latest hat and back protector standards.

All hats must be tagged

On the XC course for all heights there is no gate or slip rail to ensure the smooth running of the Hunter Trials.

No changes will be made on the day

The decisions of the judges are final throughout.






Ages taken as from 1st January 2019.

No horse or pony may compete more than once.

The event will run under Pony Club Rules for 2019, except where otherwise stated.

Hats marked with one of the following CE marks and a quality symbol must be worn at all times when mounted:

The hat standards accepted as of 1st January 2019 are detailed in the table below:

All Pony Club members must have their hats tagged.

Body protectors are compulsory and must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) or BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label).

Any rider using the Woof Wear Exo body cage must lodge a key with the event organiser when collecting their number.

If a rider chooses to wear an air vest it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall, it must be fully deflated or removed before continuing.

Medical armbands are not compulsory but are advised.

Cross country colours, hunting dress or Pony Club Dress to be worn. Long sleeves compulsory.

A horse or pony may only compete once on any given day

Objections must be made to the Secretary within 30 minutes.

Paper numbers will be provided; please bring your own number bib.

Well behaved dogs on leads are welcome.

No Recording device is permitted.

Stopwatches may be worn for classes 1 and 4 only

All horses and ponies must be fully vaccinated with passports available for inspections when collecting numbers.
