Class 4 Intermediate - any age	90cm
Class 4Q Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival PC Challenge - any age	90cm
Class 5 Open - any age	100cm

Max heights are as above for Section A with a maximum increase of 10cm in Section B.

1. All classes will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping [Rules 2021](#) and in accordance with Area 5 Winter League [Rules](#) August 2020 over a single-phase course (see below) Points will be awarded in accordance with the Area 5 Winter League Rules.
2. Branches entering more than one team in any one class must name all teams and clearly identify their Winter League Team.
3. Class 3Q and 4Q – Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Debut & PC Challenge Qualifiers except where varied in The Pony Club Spring Festival Show Jumping [Rules 2021-2](#) will run in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping 2020 Rule Book. See below for rules summary
4. Ages as at 1st January 2021.

Points will be awarded in accordance with the Area 5 Winter League Rules.

Team and individual rosettes to 6th place in classes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Individual rosettes to 6th place in classes 3Q and 4Q

Prizes: 1st to 3rd ~Team and Individual

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There will be a course change between each class and a 10 min course walk before the start of each class.

All classes will be run as single phase.

You must conform to current Covid regulations.

PLEASE NOTE

It is mandatory for all Riders to wear a protective helmet at all times when mounted. It must bear the CE mark and a quality symbol, either the BSI Kitemark, the SAI Global symbol or the official Snell label with number. The CE symbol on its own is not sufficient to ensure consistent standard of manufacture. The PAS 015:1998 and the Snell E2001 meet higher impact criteria and therefore give more protection. Hats must be approved by the Organisers before commencement of your class.

Correct riding attire in accordance with the Pony Club rules, should be worn. For safety reasons long hair must be secured above the collar. Correct Footwear must be worn by all riders. All body piercings must be removed including earrings.



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Important information

Please familiarise yourselves with all the rules- follow the links.

Members will be required to print their own numbers.

Please do not muck out horse boxes in the car park. Please put litter in the bins provided or take it home with you.

Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside boxes/trailers and left unattended.

All accidents must be reported to the show secretary for inclusion in the accident book.

All classes will be judged in accordance with Pony Club rules. The decisions of the committee and judges are final.

If any horse/pony has been in contact with strangles or any other infectious disease, it should not attend the show.

Equine Influenza Vaccine Compliance

All Horses/Ponies Vaccination should comply with rules for PCUK. Details can be found at;
