

LEADING RIDER AWARD: - Awarded to the Horse/Rider Combination gaining the most points during the Show. To be eligible for the "leading rider award" competitors must compete on each day of the Show. Points will be awarded as follows:

1st - 10 points down to 1 point for 10th place. In the case of equal placing in any competition the points will be added together and divided by the number of riders involved i.e. 2 riders in equal 3rd place would score, 8 + 7 points divided by 2 = 7.5 points for each rider. In the event of equality of points after the last jumping competition the horse/rider combination with the most 1st prizes will be the winner, or if still equal the most 2nd prizes, and so on down the line.

REGULATIONS

1. The members of the Committee of the Shropshire Horticultural Society are appointed Stewards.
2. Entry Fee must accompany each entry, but 50% will be refunded in the event of a horse being unable to compete, providing application is made to the Secretary before 2nd August 2022 together with Badges and Tickets that have been issued and to which the owner is not entitled are returned.
3. If required, a ballot of excess entries will be held and Exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after the closing date should any of their entries be balloted out.
4. Entries in all British Show Jumping Classes are confined to Registered Horses ridden by Members in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 79.
5. Declarations must be made 30 minutes before commencement of each class.
6. Objections will be dealt with in accordance with British Showjumping Rule 198 and must be handed in writing to the Secretary within half-an-hour of incident together with a deposit of £100. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
7. Competitors must at all times wear correct riding clothes complete with jackets as specified in British Showjumping rule 101.

Regulations for Competitions Jumped under Table A9 Two Round Competition –

The Best 5 Scores, or, all clear rounds will go forward to the second round, which will be against the clock. In the event of equality, faults and time will decide i.e. the faster four faulters will qualify. All scores in the first round will be carried forward to the second round. Competitors in the second round will start in the reverse order of merit or the slowest four faulters will go first, the faster clear last. If necessary, those who do not reach the second round, faults and time in the first round will determine their placing. If a competitor withdraws from the 2nd round he/she will receive the placing from the 1st round, however, he/she will be placed after those who compete in the 2nd round. At least 5 places will be awarded.
