## **Important Information**

Hats to be tagged in line with new 2023 Hat rules. No exceptions.

Please DO NOT muck out horse boxes or trailers in the car park.

Please take it home with you.

Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside horseboxes/trailers and left unattended.

All accidents should be reported to the show secretary for inclusion in the accident book

If any horse/pony has been in contact with strangles or any other infectious disease, it should not attend the competition.

## **Equine Influenza/Vaccine Compliance**

All horses/ponies vaccination should comply with rules for PCUK.
