 https://pcuk.org/media/ct3d1j5q/show-jumping-rule-book-2023.pdf over a single-phase course divided into two sections section A, over 5 to 7 obstacles, to be untimed or time allowed; section B, over 5 to 7 obstacles, to be timed. Maximum 12 obstacles in total.

 Class 1 will be over a reduced number of obstacles in each section with a maximum of 10.
- **2**. Classes 2,3,4,5, and 6 the Area 5 Winter League classes, will also be run in accordance with Area 5 Winter League Rules to accommodate WL and non-WL teams and individuals with appropriate course changes where necessary. Points will be awarded in accordance with the Area 5 Winter League Rules.
- **3.** Branches entering more than one team in any one class must clearly identify their Winter League Team and multiple branch teams to be named to distinguish.
- **4.** Ages as at 1st January 2023 PC Membership will be confirmed with branch.
- **5.** In all Pony Club Show Jumping, excessive use of the whip, including repeated slapping down the shoulder, is prohibited. The rules state that the whip may be used a maximum of three times during any round.
- **6.** Passports for all horses and ponies MUST be carried and available for inspection and prove vaccination valid in accordance with the Pony Club Equine Influenza Rules, see:
